# NARRATIVE REPORT FOR AMOR MATERNITY AT KASESE HEALTH CENTRE IN DOWA DISTRICT REPORTING MONTH: NOVEMBER, 2011

### **Family Planning**

- A total of 490 clients accessed family planning services in November, 2011.
- The Majority (383) of the clients chose depo- provera, 47 chose implant, 37 chose oral contraceptives while 23 went for codoms.
- 540 condoms were distributed during the month.




Fig. 1: Family Planning Type of Clients

- The data on family planning methods usage has been summarized in **figure 1** below.

#### **Maternity Services (AMOR)**

The total number of babies born at the clinic since **AMOR Maternity unit** became operational in August 2009 has reached **1,213** including fifty which were delivered in November 2011. The Maternity unit statistics for the Maternity unit have been summarised in figure 4 below.

- All 50 deliveries born in November, 2011 at Kasese AMOR Maternity unit were conducted by skilled health workers (Nurse/Midwives).
- There were no deliveries in-transit to the maternity unit. There were no neonatal nor maternal death recorded during the month.
- 60 women came for postnatal check-up at 2 weeks.

#### Prenatal (Antenatal) Care

- A total of 149 pregnant women registered (new) and received focused antenatal care through Lifeline Malawi clinics in November, 2011.
- Only 26 (17.4%) of the new pregnant women reported within 0 -12 weeks of their pregnancy, 123 reported in the second trimester.
- 69 women received recommended 2 doses of Sulphadoxine Pyrimethamine (SP) tablets as presumptive Therapy for Malaria.
- 12 women received 0-1 dose of Tetenus Toxoid Vacine (TTV) while 103 women received 2+ doses of TTV.

#### Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission of HIV (PMTCT) November 2011

- All the 65 pregnant mothers admitted to AMOR maternity unit were tested for HIV before delivery or referral they
  were all negative.
- A total of 77 came for Antenatal services amongst them 43 registered for the first time were all tested for HIV and 3 previous positive were initiated on ART. A total of nine pregnant mothers accessed ARTservices during the month.

#### HIV Counselling and Testing statistics for November, 2011

- A total of 520 clients accessed HTC services of which 183 of coming for the first time were tested and given results. Out of the 183 coming for the first time 6 were positive. 206 were revisit and 11 were reactive.
- A total of 114 accessing HTC services came with their spouses.
- A total of 701 male condoms and 299 female condoms were distributed during the month. There were a total of 14 new clients tested for HIV at the outreach and 34 were revisiting one was reactive and two came with their partners.

#### Antiretroviral Therapy (ART)

- In November, 2011, there were 26 starters (6 female, 20 male), they were all above the age of 18 years.
- 8 patients (over 18 yrs) were transferred in from other clinics.
- There was one defaulter and one deaths reported in November, 2011.

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• A total of 51 patients are on CPT and amongst these 18 of them are below the age of 18

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
